Description: A walk on the levee of the West Fork of the Trinity River, passing a hidden waterfall along the way to Airfield Falls Trailhead and Conservation Park. The Park was once part of Carswell AFB. Carswell closed by 1994 and is now known as Naval Air Station Joint Reserve Base Fort Worth and is home to the Air Force Reserve, Navy Reserve, Marine Corps Reserve and Air National Guard flying units.

RESTROOMS

The Preserve opens at 8:00 a.m. but the restroom at the Interpretive Center is **not available until 9:00 a.m.** when the Center opens. You may wish to stop for your convenience before you arrive. There are a couple of restrooms elsewhere in the Preserve, but **none on the walk routes.**

DIRECTIONS

Melva Campbell Park: I-30 take exit 9B Horne St./Camp Bowie Blvd. E bound LEFT on Horne. W bound RIGHT on Horne St. (Horne changes name to Roaring Springs Rd). RIGHT on Fursman Ave. LEFT on Burton Hill Rd. RIGHT at 311 (towards Police Dept) and park in the back by the park.

Fort Worth Nature Center: 9601 Fossil Ridge Road Fort Worth, TX 76135. From Loop I-820, exit Hwy 199 (Jacksboro Highway) and go west 4 miles. Exit Confederate Park Rd. to the right and stay on service road. At the stop sign, turn right onto Buffalo Road into the Nature Center entrance. Stop at gate house to obtain a day pass and trail map. The first 50 AVA walkers (**mention TVA Meeting**) get in free. Website: <https://www.fwnaturecenter.org/> .

Kroger Parking Lot: 3120 University Dr., Fort Worth, TX 76109. North- or southbound on I-35 South in Fort Worth, EXIT Berry St. Turn west for 2 ½ miles to S. University Dr. Turn left. The parking lot will be on your right. *Kroger is not a sponsor or party to this walk.*
